2-10	entries	-	1	Award of Merit
11-20	entries	-	2	Awards of Merit
21-30	entries	-	3	Awards of Merit
31-40	entries	-	4	Awards of Merit
41 +	entries	-	5	Awards of Merit

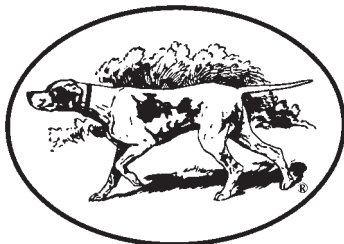

RULES
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

JUDGING

- A. The judging starts promptly. During the hours of judging exhibitors are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly.
- B. The owner of the dog or the handler is responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging ring. There is no rule of this Club or the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.
- C. **All cell phones, pagers, beepers, etc., must be on “mute” or “vibrate” when in the ring area. Persons with ringing or toning cell phones, pagers, beepers, etc., will be escorted from the ring area. NO CELL PHONE PHOTOS/VIDEOS ARE PERMITTED.**
- E. **Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge**, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs & Xoloitzcuintli.. (Whippets may be examined on the ground, on a table or on a ramp.) **Basset Hounds** are expected to be judged on ramp during breed judging.
This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations.
Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)



- F. Regardless of the ownership of the dog(s) one exhibitor's gate admission is sent for each dog entered. The gate admission is valid for both days of the show and is needed for admittance. The person accompanying the dog must show an admission ticket and the dog identification before the dog will be admitted. **DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED.** There is no provision for unentered dogs at this show. **Exhibitors must preserve their dog identifications which must be surrendered when dogs are removed from the show.**
- G. Your ticket(s) do NOT allow access into the arena on days other than the two Dog Show Days. There is **ABSOLUTELY NO ACCESS** to the arena from the benching area at any time prior to the show, unless you have tickets to the arena floor. Anyone caught trying to access the arena floor will be escorted from the building and have their dog show passes confiscated and will not be permitted to return.

CITY LAWS

- A. The Director of the Bureau of Animal Affairs of New York City requires all dogs entering the City of New York to be accompanied by a Health Certificate issued by a licensed Veterinarian no more than 7 days prior to arrival in the City.
- B. New York City law states that people exercising dogs are responsible for cleaning-up the feces. The law is strictly enforced and punishable by a \$100.00 fine. The Department of Sanitation will be enforcing the "Pooper-Scooper" law and will be writing tickets for fines in the amount of \$100.00. Dog waste both inside and outside the building **MUST** be picked up and disposed of sanitarly. Failure to do so may result in an Event Committee hearing and/or refusal of future entries by this club.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

EQUIPMENT

- A. The Club and its Superintendent provide assistance to exhibitors and handlers in unloading and placing their crates and grooming tables. Crate and grooming areas will be arranged in rows and aisles to facilitate exhibitors and to expedite the safe and smooth operation of the show. By entering this show, exhibitors and handlers agree to follow all directions of the special assistants charged with arranging and maintaining orderly conditions in these areas. Abuse of these assistants will not be tolerated.
- B. **Grooming tables in excess of 24 x 36 inches are not permitted. Tables must be folded when not in use. Grooming of dogs in areas other than the grooming and Multi-Breed benching section is not permitted. Tack Units in Multi-Breed benching area must be on the bench.**
- C. **No Flexi/retractable leads permitted at this show.**
- D. **Fabric crates are not permitted at this show.**

- E. **No private exercise pens are allowed anywhere in the show precincts. Public exercise pens will be for multiple dogs at all times. Dogs must be on lead in exercise pens. No exceptions. A separate area will be provided for bitches in season. Owners/handlers are to clean-up after their dogs. Blocking off exercise pens is NOT permitted.**
- F. **No chairs, tables, or other furniture are allowed in the benching areas or aisles of the show, and no chairs will be allowed in the crate and grooming areas.**
- G. Handbills, circulars, or other printed matter may not be distributed at this show.
- H. All cords on floor must be taped down to avoid tripping hazards.

BENCHING

- A. Dogs are received only at the exhibitors' entrance, corner of 33rd St. & Pennsylvania Plaza between 7th and 8th Avenues, beginning at 6:00 A.M. E.T., each morning.
- B. Dogs must arrive by 11:30 A.M. E.T. on the day they are judged. Dogs arriving after 11:30 A.M. E.T. will not be admitted, and no entry fees will be returned. All dogs must be removed from the benches by 11:30 P.M. E.T. Tuesday evening to the designated holding area. **TUESDAY BREEDS will not be admitted until 9:00 P.M. Monday evening.**
- C. **Dogs and equipment cannot be removed from the show either day before 8:00 P.M. E.T.** Spectators buying items from concessionaires must show sales receipts to guards at the gates for any items they wish to take from the building before 8:00 P.M. E.T. All dogs must be removed from Madison Square Garden by midnight Tuesday. See also separate note regarding release forms on page 9. **It is your responsibility to have the appropriate release forms to exit the building with dogs/equipment.**



- D. Exhibitors wanting dogs of the same breed/variety benched together must have completed the benching form provided in the premium list and forwarded with the entries. It should be clearly understood that cancelling an entry in order to re-enter it with another is a violation of this provision and in such an instance the Superintendent would be under no obligation to bench the dogs together. **There will be no switching from breed section to multi-breed benching or vice-versa. There will be no switching between handlers' spaces. NO EXCEPTIONS.** ID's will state where dog is benched. It is your responsibility to send complete, correct information.
- E. **Dogs of different breeds/varieties will be benched together provided they have the same agent and that agent has at least four (4) different breeds (not varieties) entered on each day they wish to be in the Multi-Breed area. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- F. Under no circumstances may exhibitors change their bench numbers.
- G. Tape only may be used to attach signs and decorations to benches; that is, no nails, carpet tacks, thumb tacks, or staples may be used. All decorations must be fire-retardant. No signs over 11" x 14" may be displayed. No sign may exceed the top of the benching. No signs may be displayed on the bench other than a plaque or emblem of a show-giving Specialty Club to which the dog's owner belongs, or giving the kennel name & address of the owner. No prizes or ribbons shall be displayed on the bench except those won by the dog at this show. Benching sizes are as follows: Small 18w" x 32d"; medium, 23w" x 36d" and large, 31w" x 42d".
- H. Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows is strictly enforced. The benching of dogs is an integral part of the dog show, the importance of which cannot be overstated. **Exhibitors/Handlers who do not adhere to the benching requirements of the AKC and The Westminster Kennel Club as noted in this premium list run the risk of The Westminster Kennel Club refusing all future entries from you for their show.** In addition, dogs are presumed to be under the care custody and control of the person(s) listed on the entry form. Neglect of a dog on the bench could result in an Event Committee hearing.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

- A. The Management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or property of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the show premises. See also the agreement on the reverse of the entry form.

- B. The welfare of an exhibitor's/spectator's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor/spectator. It is expressly understood that exhibitors/spectators will exercise control and restraint over their children while they are on the show premises.

- C. The Westminster Kennel Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

AGREEMENT

- A. By entering this show, all participants agree to the following: All rights to advertise, promote, publicize, televise or otherwise exploit the show are vested in The Westminster Kennel Club and its assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses, voices or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, and kennels participating in the show.

- B. MADISON SQUARE GARDEN PROHIBITS THE USE OF VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES AT THIS SHOW. THIS INCLUDES CELL PHONE RECORDINGS.

C. The Westminster Kennel Club reserves the right to broadcast or cause to be broadcast any or all portions of The Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show by any means of known transmission of video material.

D. SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS: ALL REQUESTS FOR THE HIRING OF PRIVATE GUARDS FOR THE WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW MUST BE MADE THROUGH DOG SECURITY AT MADISON SQUARE GARDEN (212-631-5350) AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2008, AND BEFORE NOON ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2009, FOR BOTH THE ORDER AND PAYMENT. THERE WILL BE AN EIGHT (8) HOUR MINIMUM SHIFT AND PAYMENT IN ADVANCE IS REQUIRED.

In the interest of having a cleaner show, we are asking all exhibitors and agents to make a concerted effort in keeping the benching, grooming, and ring areas neat. Extra trash receptacles are provided. Please keep your areas of benching and grooming clean throughout the day and give it special attention as you leave at night. PLEASE MAKE AN EFFORT TO CONFINE YOUR DOG'S ELIMINATIONS TO THE X-PENS.

NOTE:

Release times are published in the judging program and are enforced. Dogs WILL NOT be released from the building without the appropriate signed release form. **There will be no one available to furnish release forms after 9:00 P.M. E.T. Friday, Saturday and Sunday. If you do not have your dog's admittance ID form, release forms for Monday and Tuesday nights must be obtained prior to 11:00 P.M. E.T. Abuse of the Guards will not be tolerated. It is your responsibility to have the appropriate release forms and to vacate the building before the ramp and elevator closing hours.**

The Department of Sanitation will be enforcing the "Pooper-Scooper" law and will be writing tickets for fines in the amount of \$100.00. Dog waste both inside and outside the building MUST be picked up and disposed of sanitarily. Failure to do so may result in a Event Committee hearing and/or refusal of future entries by this club.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Juniors receive a separate admission pass. Misuse of this Junior Pass could result in an Event Committee hearing, removal from the show and/or exclusion from future competition at this show.

Juniors who substitute for the original dog they have entered in the Junior Showmanship Class with dogs that are not entered in one of the offered classes at this show will not incur an additional fee.

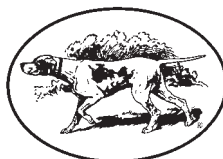
EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

BENCHING NUMBERS

Your benching number is the same as your dog's armband/catalog number, which appears on your ID form. The number does not indicate benching sequence. NOTE: Rows may shift slightly due to reported absentees. All rows will be marked with overhead signs.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.



RAMP HOURS

No exhibitor vehicles will be permitted up the ramp. All exhibitor unloading is at the bottom of ramp in unloading area. Exhibitors not requiring assistance please use freight or Tower B elevators. No dogs or exhibitors permitted to walk on ramp.

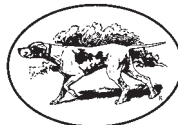

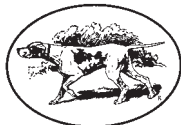

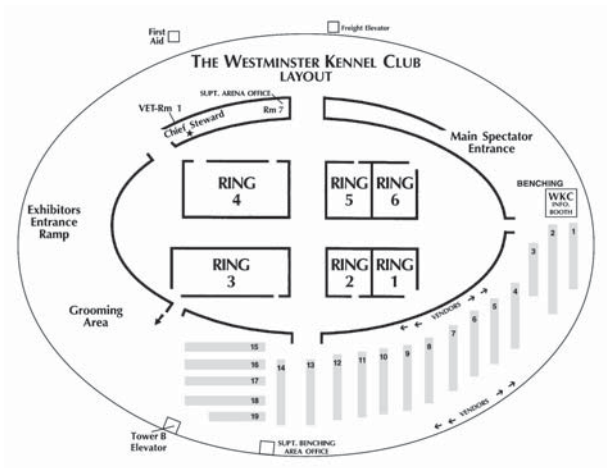
